- **4- Performances:** It was an exceptional season regarding the participation of our athletes at different competitions in different levels and different categories. And the results were excellent at all categories.



Challenges and recommendations.

Development:

- a- Increasing the MFA memberships fencers in the next two years.
- b- As we will have more certified coaches, we need to look to create new clubs in different areas and run more school demonstrations.
- c- Keep Promoting our tournaments to get fencers from outside the province.
- d- Targeting more the Under 12 age category in our school program demonstrations.
- e- Organising at least one regional tournament in Winnipeg with the coordination with Alberta and Saskatchewan.
- f- Increase the local competitions number for youth categories and creating new categories separated by level and fencing experiences.
- g- Invite and motivate our provincial referees to run for a national level examination.
- h- Motivate our coaches to go look for the next education level.
- i- Keep running coaching and refereeing courses.

Provincial Team:

- a- Increase the High-Performance athletes from the results based.
- **b-** Better organize the individual training within the squad groups to avoid that a lot of squad athletes could not get their private training.
- c- With that big number of the PT we will be dividing the groups into levels which will results that they will be training in different times.
- d- As the specific strength training is going very well and we are very happy with the athlete's improvement, we will strongly be recommending it for our HP, Int and YHP mandatory in their program level.
- e- Next coming season, our regional competitions will be in different provinces. There will be regional in Montreal, Toronto, Vancouver and Calgary based on the strength of the weapons.
- f- Also, we will still be participating in the US Regionals as well and some fencers will go to North American Circuits.

Facility:

a- The MFA is working to find solution for our eternal facility problem. The size that the provincial team got, we need bigger gym to le all our fencers train together and get more training volume.
